CSEI attend the second World Congress on Condition Monitoring (WCCM 2019) in Singapore with fruitful outcomes

The second World Congress on Condition Monitoring (WCCM 2019) co-sponsored by the International Condition Monitoring Committee (ISCM) and the Singapore Non-destructive Testing Institute (NDTSS) was held in Singapore from 2nd to 5th December. WCCM as one of the top conferences in condition monitoring field enjoys high international influence. During the meeting, as the chairman of the third world conference on condition monitoring (WCCM2021), researcher Shen Gongtian took over the flag of WCCM from Professor Ien Gelman, chairman of ISCM, and made a report on the preparations for the third world conference on condition monitoring to the ISCM committee and WCCM 2019 representatives, and has been highly regarded by the participants and exhibitors, as they all expressed their active participation in the congress to be held in Beijing in 2021. WCCM 2021 will be held in Beijing, which will greatly promote the scientific and technological progress of condition monitoring and fault diagnosis in China.
